

INNOVATIVE METHODS AND THEIR ROLE IN TEACHING FOREIGN LANGUAGES

Annotation: This article describes innovative methods of teaching foreign languages in schools, academic lyceums and higher educational institutions and their advantages.

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From the first day of the Republic of Uzbekistan's choice of the path of development as an independent state, it performs a number of important tasks aimed at educating the younger generation as a comprehensively developed, intelligent, talented and worthy of the ancestors of the generation. In particular, in recent years, our esteemed President Sh. Mirziyoyev has issued several decrees and resolutions. As for foreign languages, the first President of the Republic of Uzbekistan signed Resolution No. PD 1875 of December 10, 2012 "On measures to further improve the system of learning foreign languages" and the resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of August 11, 2017. An example of this is Resolution No. 610 "On measures to further improve the quality of teaching a foreign language in educational institutions." Such decisions and decrees impose great tasks on us, teachers, such as educating the younger generation to be fully mature and capable. Currently, one of the main goals of every teacher is to provide quality education to the younger generation in every educational institution, whether it is a higher education institution or a general secondary school. One of the main problems for teachers of educational institutions is to provide quality education to students who, for various reasons, cannot attend classes, as well as to students who attend classes on a regular basis. Immerse yourself in the language environment. It is very important to try to create a proper language



environment to learn English faster. The reader can improve their understanding of English by listening to audio content such as podcasts.
